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## Guide to developing your Pecha Kucha presentation

Tips to support your preparation:

- Familiarise yourself with the specifics of this Pecha Kucha session
  - ▶ In total your presentation will be strictly five minutes long
  - ▶ Each of your slides should be displayed for twenty seconds
  - ▶ This means you should have fifteen slides prepared
- Consider your audience
  - ▶ They are interested in WIL
  - ▶ They are especially interested in new and innovative ideas about WIL
  - ▶ They may not be familiar with jargon and acronyms specific to your area
- Consider the unique features of a Pecha Kucha presentation
  - ▶ Pecha Kucha is an ideal way to present one main idea or story
  - ▶ Visually appealing slides will help illustrate and support your message
  - ▶ Text heavy slides and complex diagrams may distract from your message
- Use great Pecha Kucha presentations to inform your own stylistic approach
  - ▶ Seek out examples of effective presentation on platforms such as youtube
  - ▶ Identify the details that contribute to their appeal and effectiveness
  - ▶ Use these elements to inform your own approach
- Rehearse and seek feedback on your presentation
  - ▶ Ensure the spoken part of your presentation fits the Pecha Kucha format
  - ▶ Ask for feedback on the pace and flow of your presentation
  - ▶ Ask a listener what they think your main message is
